Driver Checklist

Trailer Checklist Before Departure:

- 1. Check if wrenches and a jack are packed and know their location.
- 2. Check the tire pressure.
- 3. Ensure that the bolts are tight.
- 4. Check that the lights on the trailer are functioning.
- 5. Verify that the brakes are working.
- 6. Ensure that the Melges is securely fastened with straps.
 - Two straps over the boat and down into the trailer.
 - Two hand straps for the boom.
 - Two hand straps for the mast.
- 7. Connect the trailer, drive with it, and perform a sudden brake. Feel for any jerking or observe any signs that the trailer is braking on its own.
- 8. Check for any loose objects that could fall off or cause damage.
 - Both outside and inside the boat.
- 9. Carry at least two extra large straps in case any are damaged or lost.
- 10. Bring the vehicle registration document (located in a folder in NTNUI Seiling's mailbox at the NTNUI clubhouse).
- 11. Check that the car can tow a sufficient load.

Trailer Checklist Upon Arrival:

- 1. Check that it is not obstructing and is parked as agreed.
- 2. Ensure that the handbrake is engaged or there are wheel blocks in place.
 - Prevents it from rolling away.
